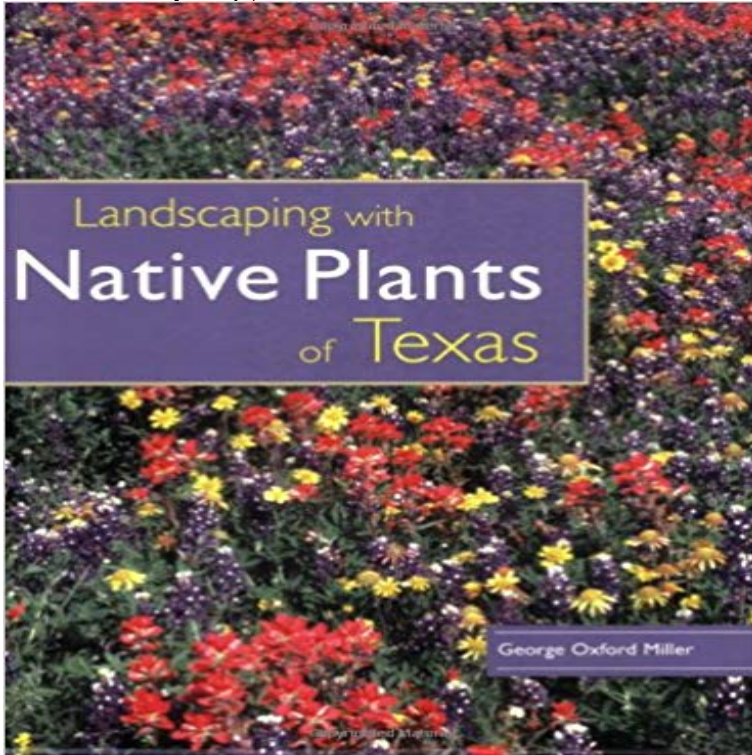


Landscaping with Native Plants of Texas
