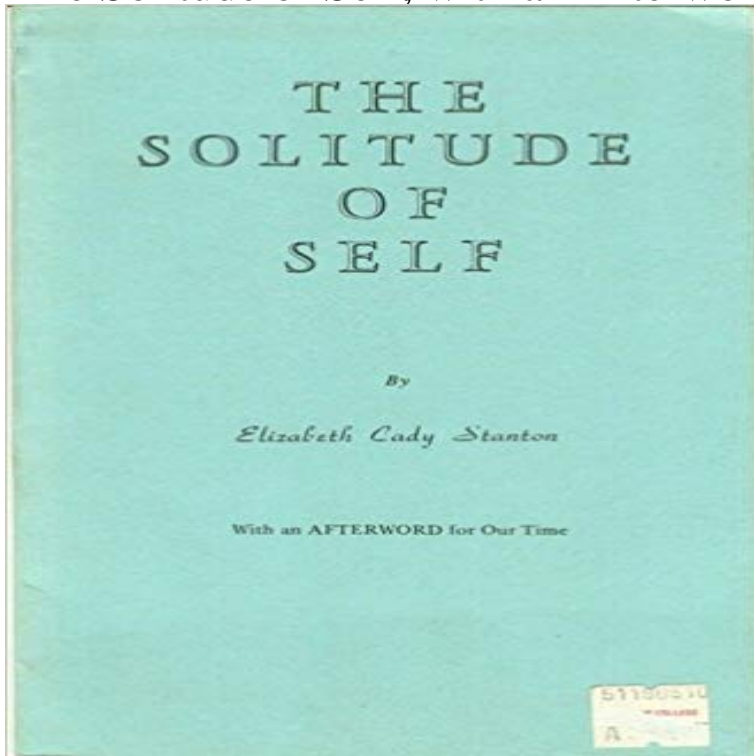


# The Solitude of Self, with an Afterword for Our Time
