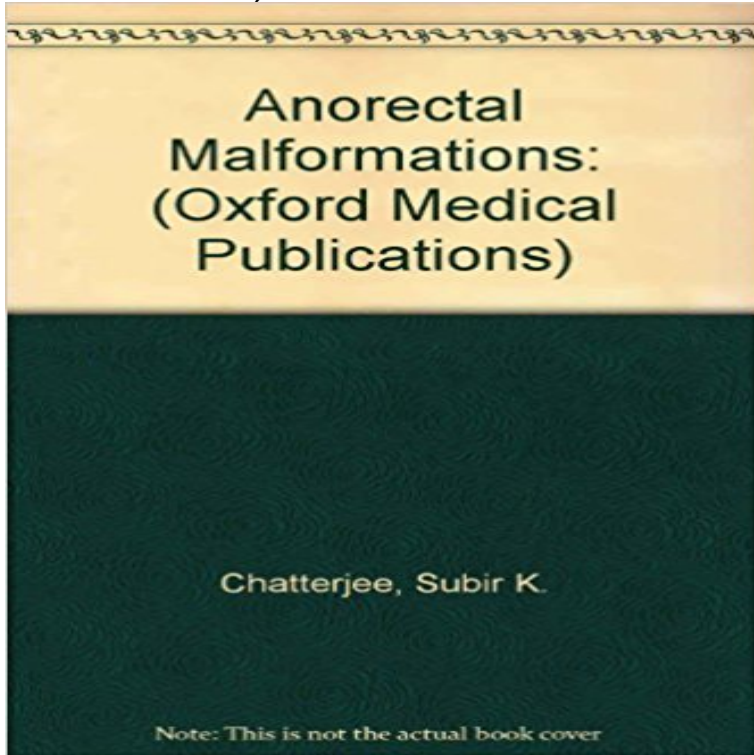


Anorectal Malformations: A Surgeons Experience (Oxford Medical Publications)
