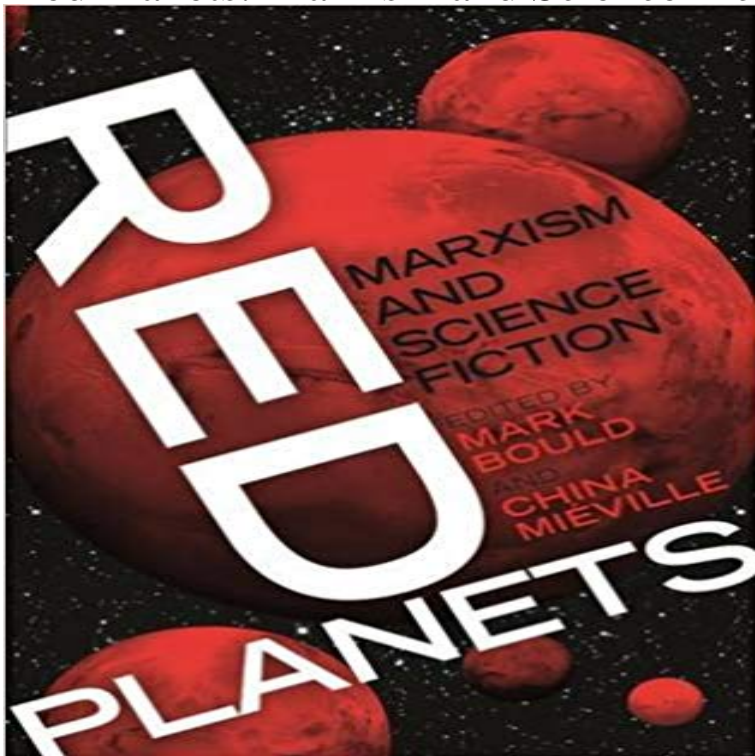


## Red Planets: Marxism and Science Fiction
