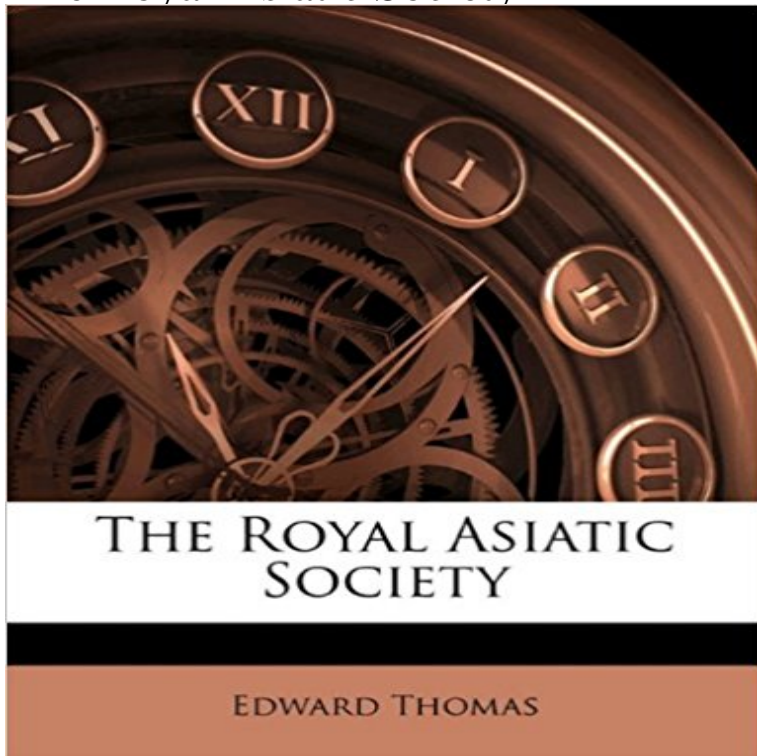


The Royal Asiatic Society
