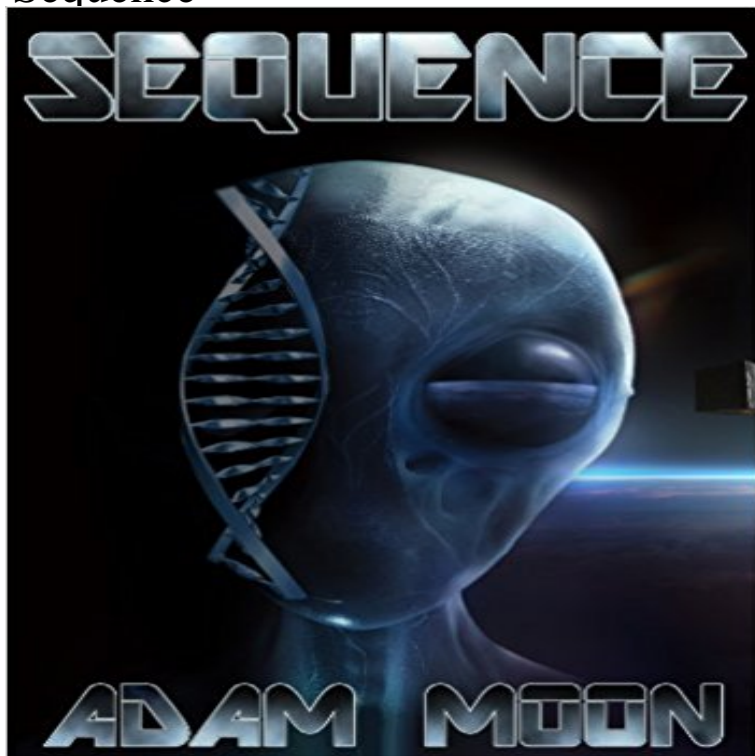


## Sequence
