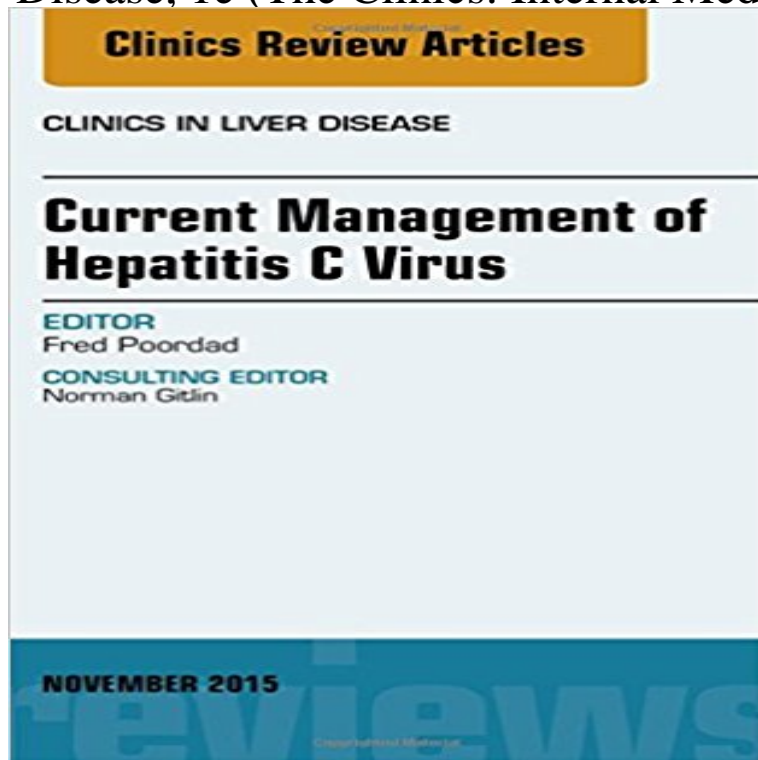


Current Management of Hepatitis C Virus, An Issue of Clinics in Liver Disease, 1e (The Clinics: Internal Medicine)
