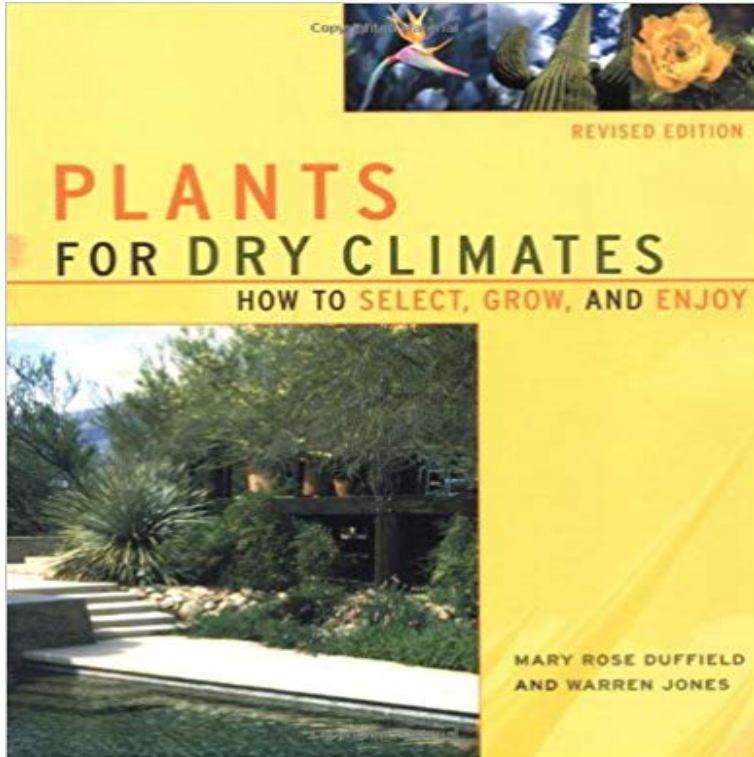


Plants For Dry Climates: How To Select, Grow, And Enjoy, Revised Edition
