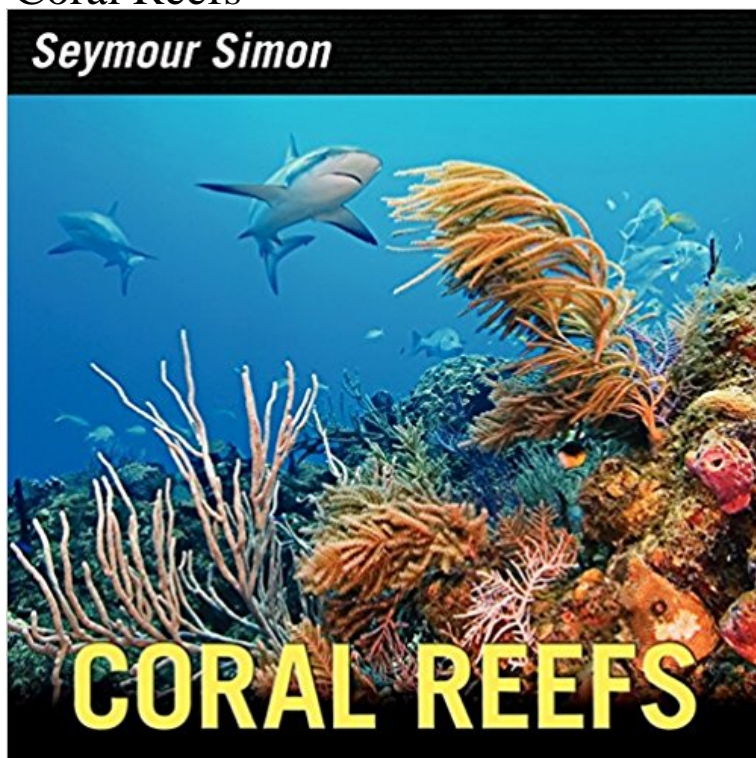


Coral Reefs
