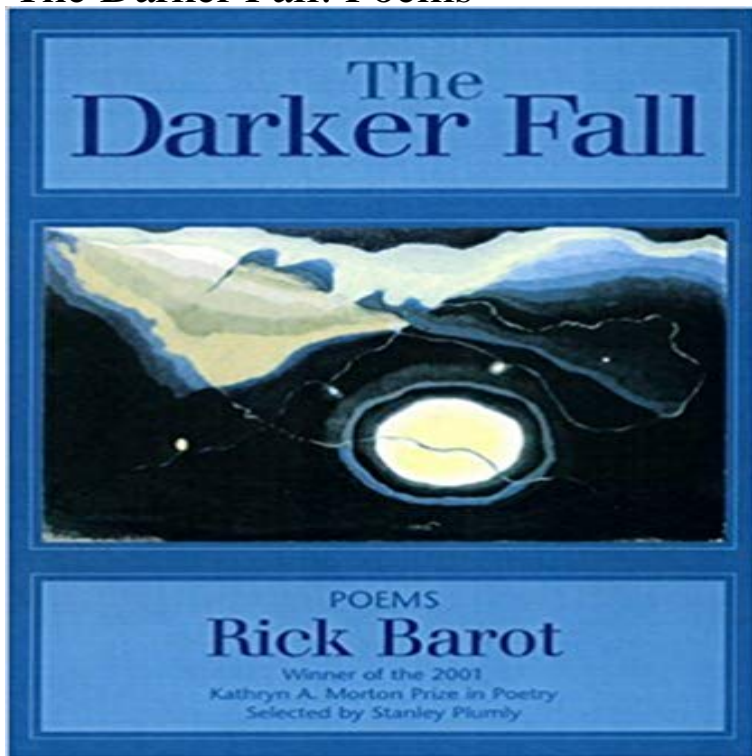


The Darker Fall: Poems
