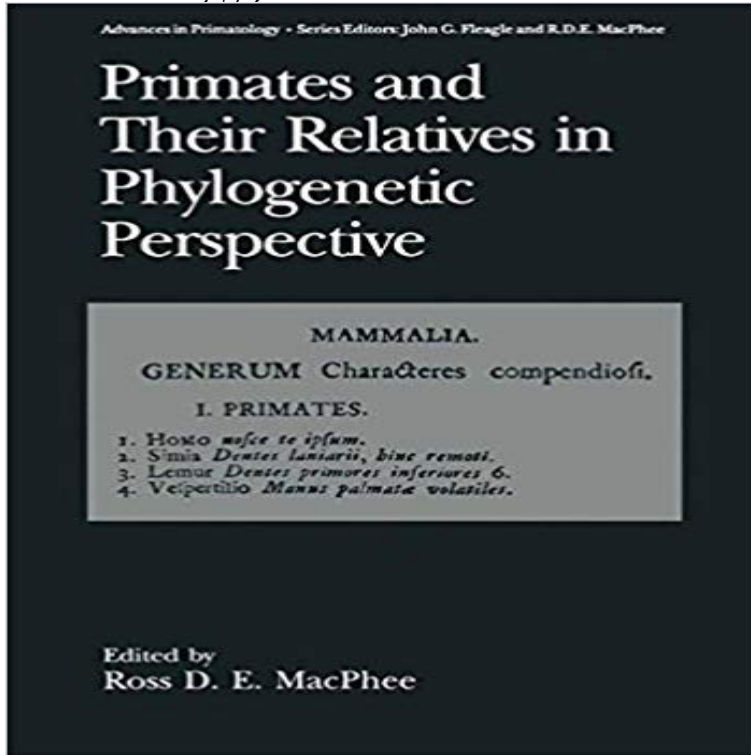


# Primates and Their Relatives in Phylogenetic Perspective (Advances in Primatology)
