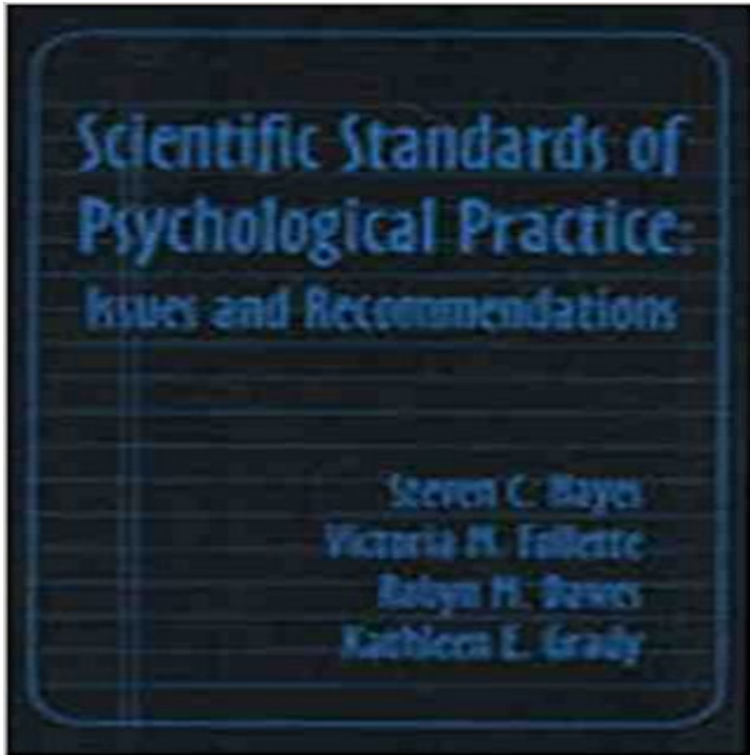


# Scientific Standards of Psychological Practice: Issues and Recommendations
