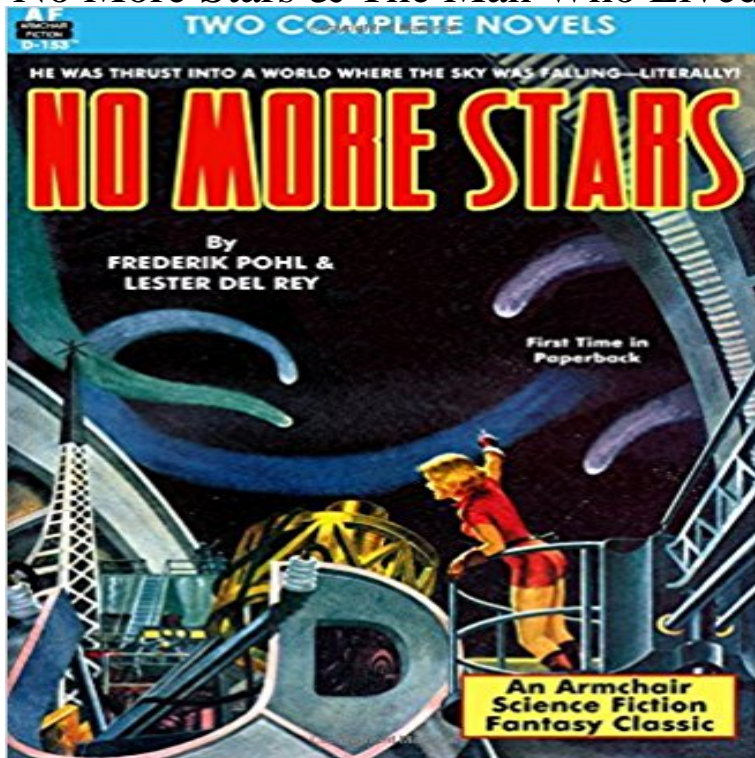


No More Stars & The Man Who Lived Forever
