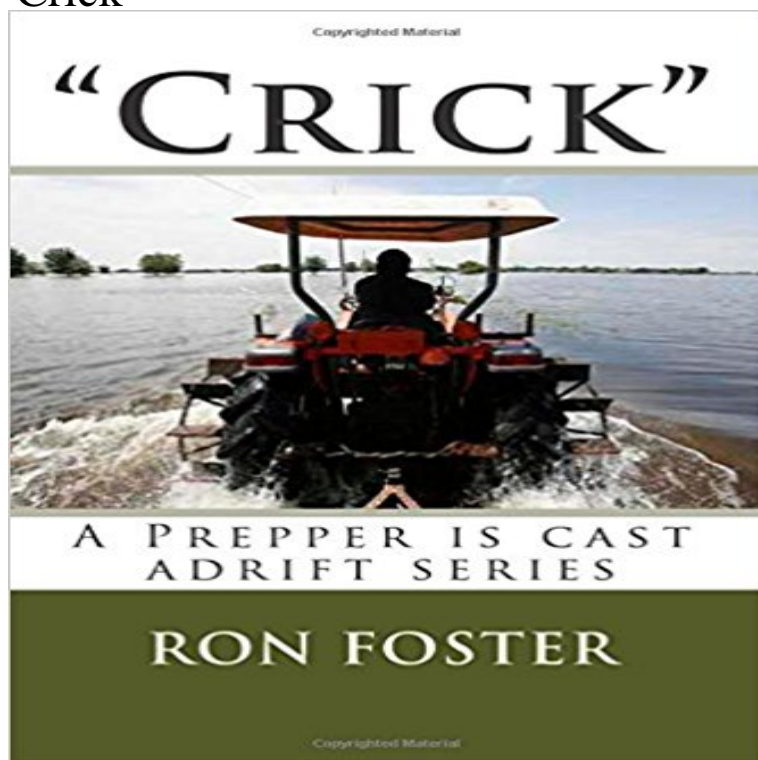


## Crick
