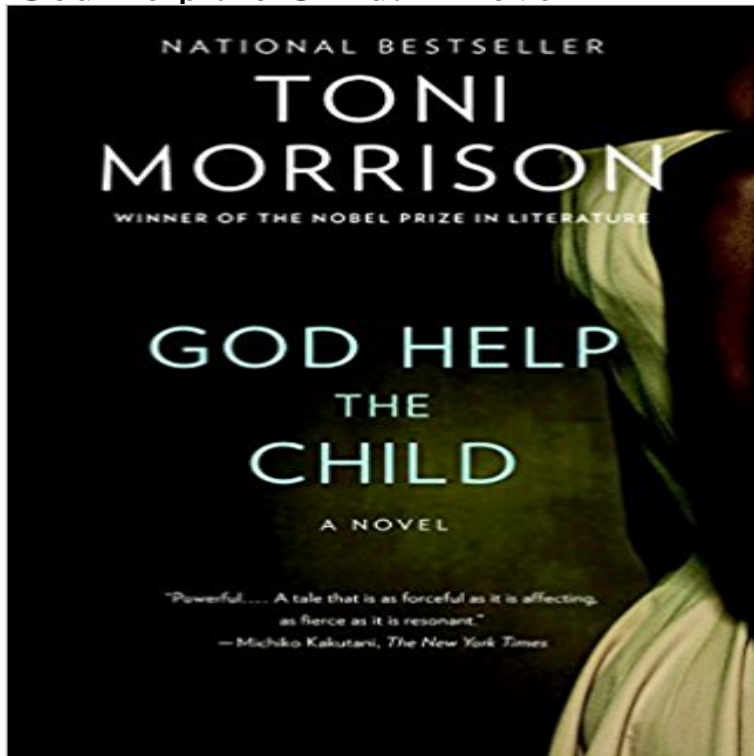


## God Help the Child: A novel
