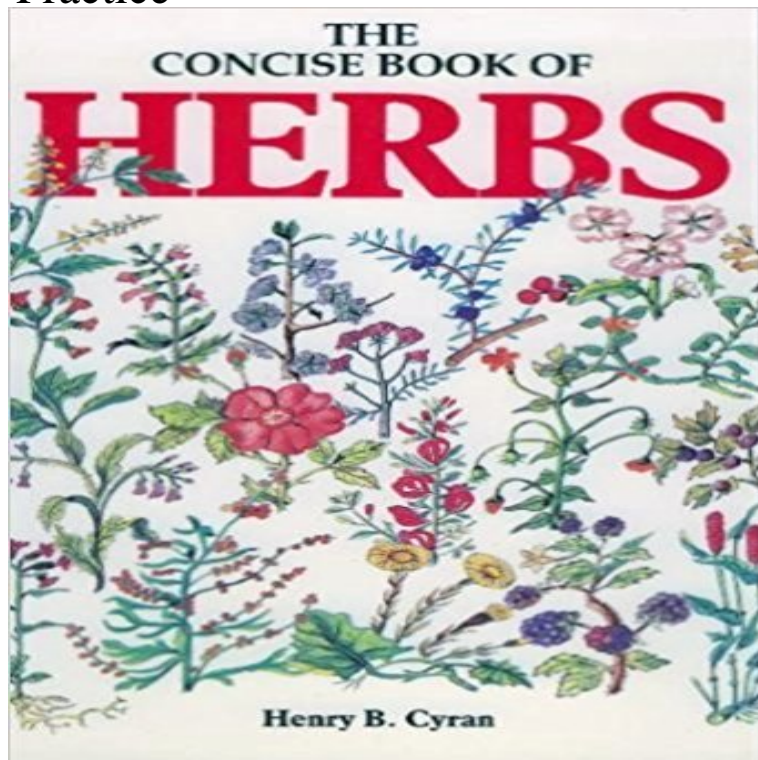


Clinical Intervention: A Philosophy and Methodology for Clinical Practice
