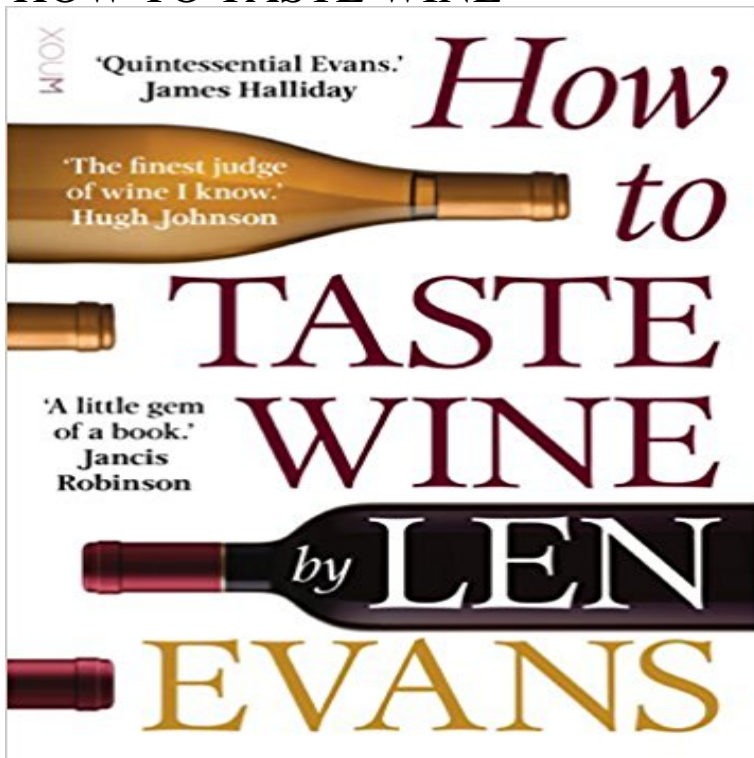


## HOW TO TASTE WINE
