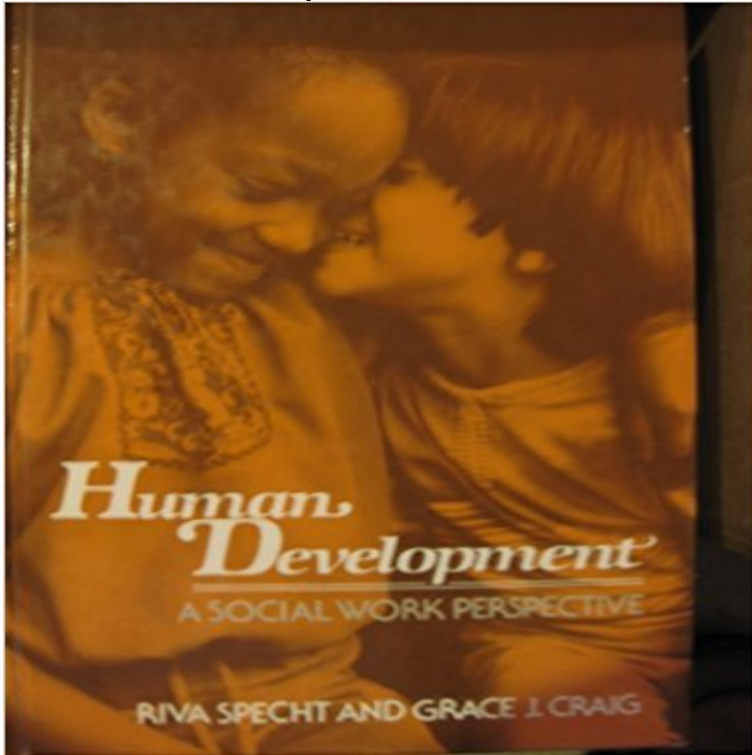


Human Development: A Social Work Perspective
