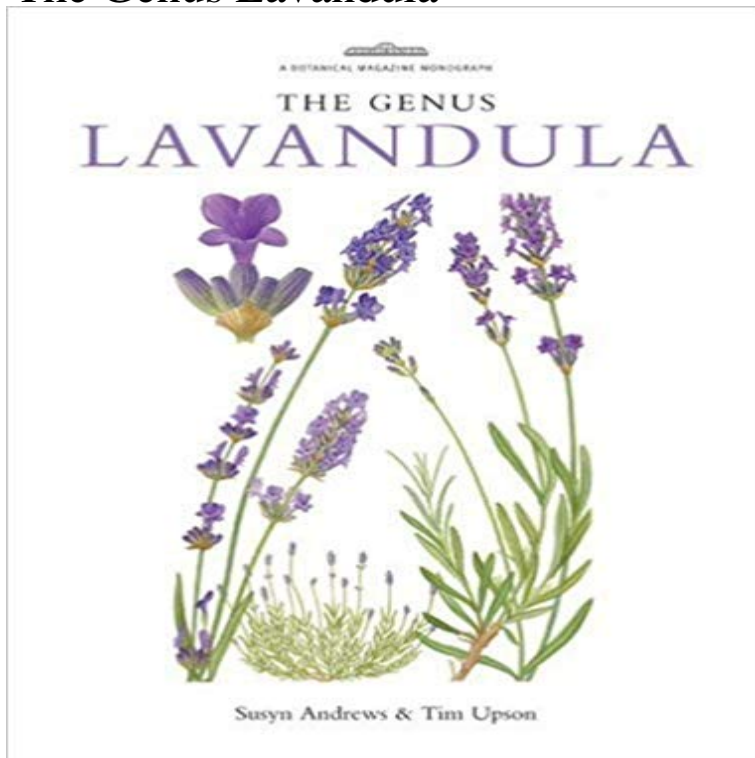


The Genus Lavandula
