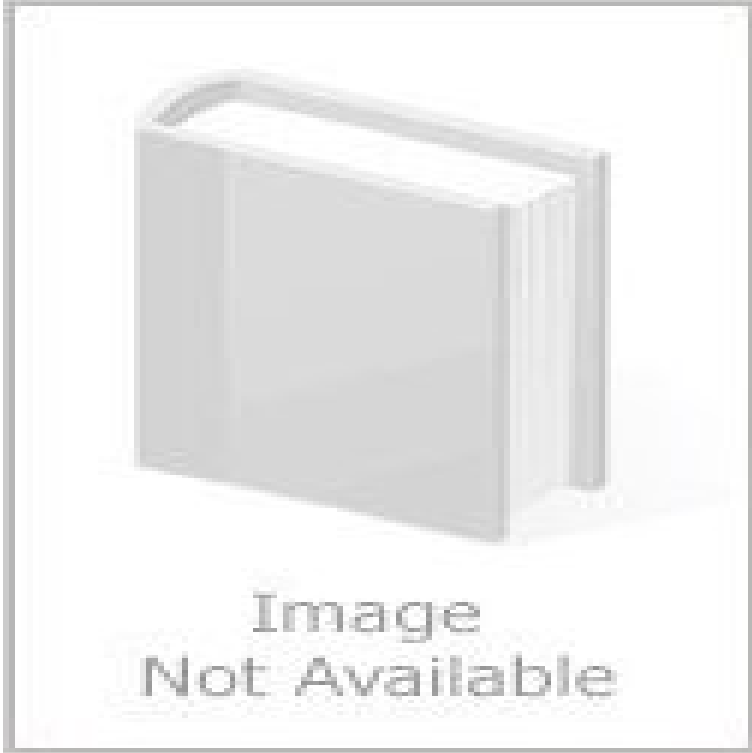


Looking North for Health: What We Can Learn from Canadas Health Care System (Jossey Bass/Aha Press Series)
