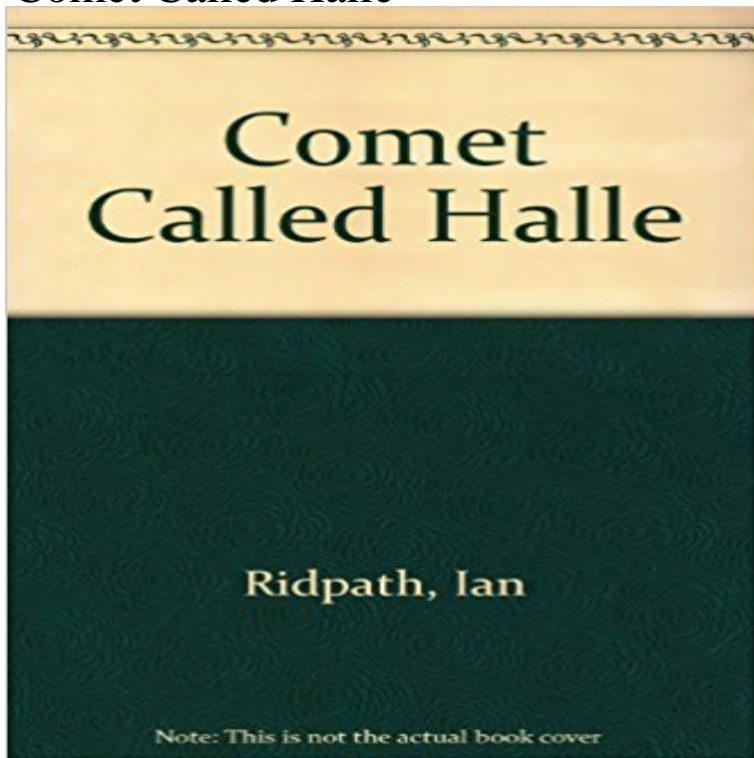


## Comet Called Halle
