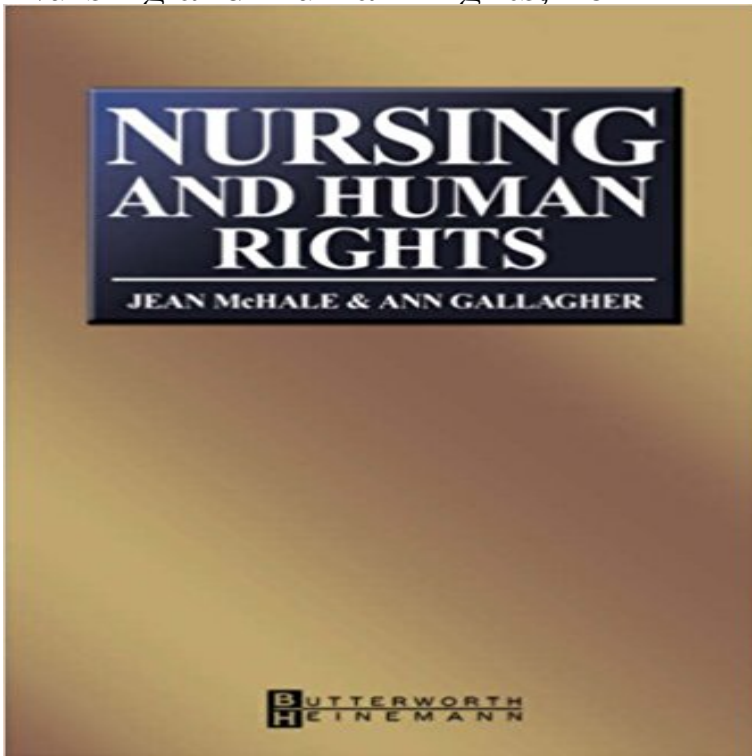


Nursing and Human Rights, 1e
