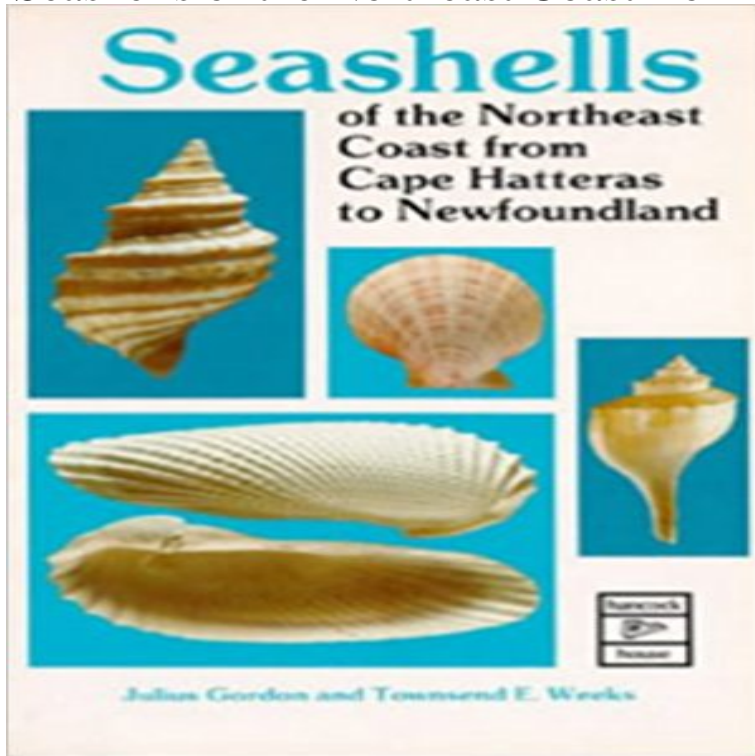


Seashells of the Northeast Coast from Cape Hatters to Newfoundland
