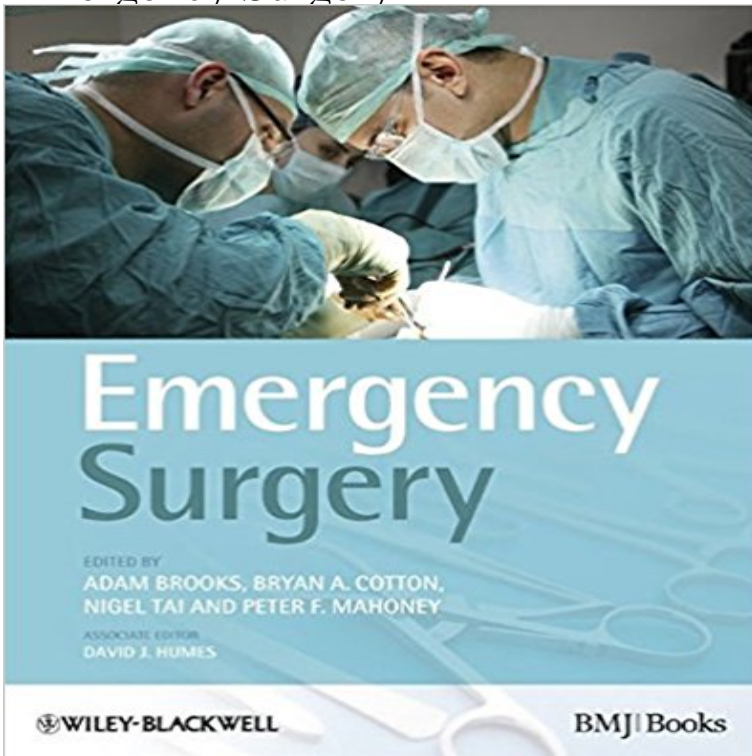


Emergency Surgery
