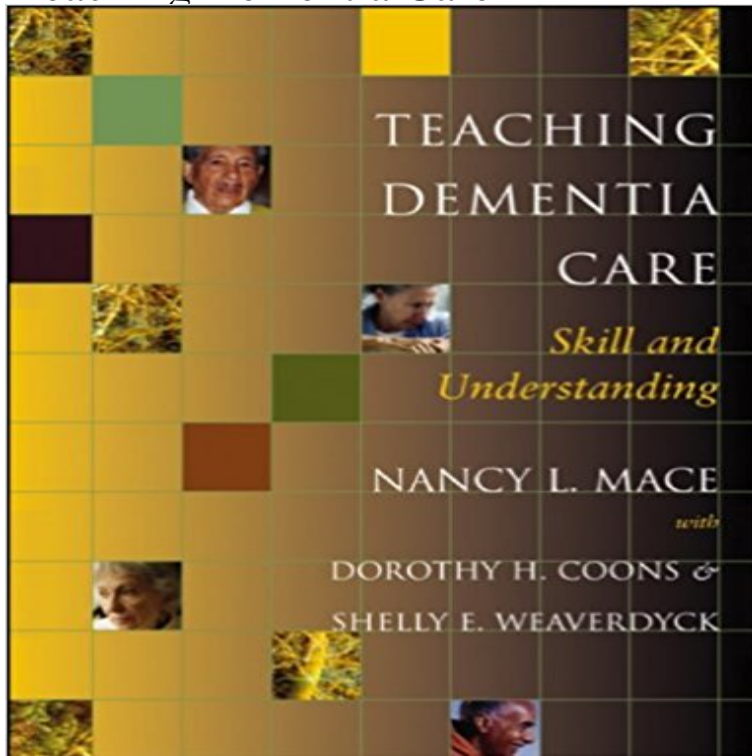


## Teaching Dementia Care
