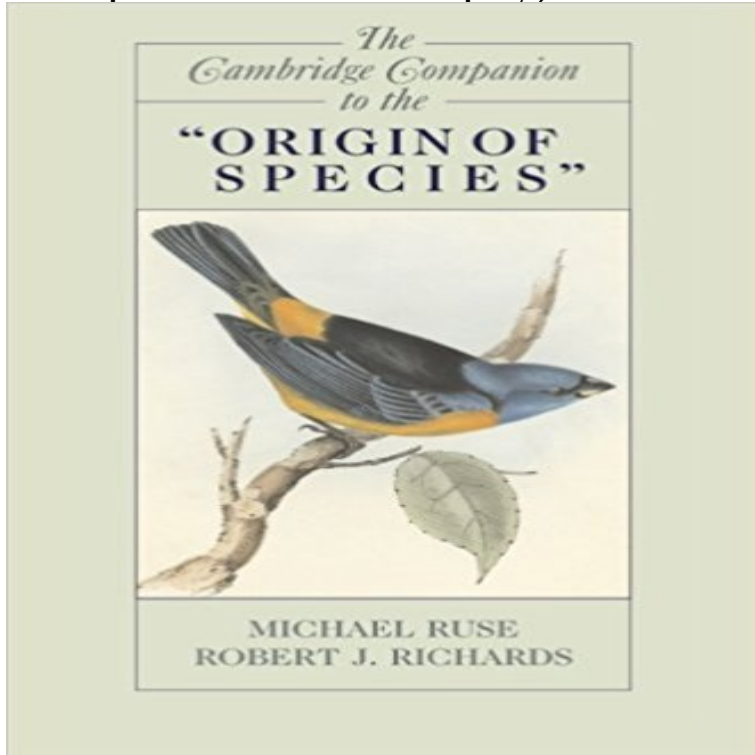


The Cambridge Companion to the Origin of Species (Cambridge Companions to Philosophy)
