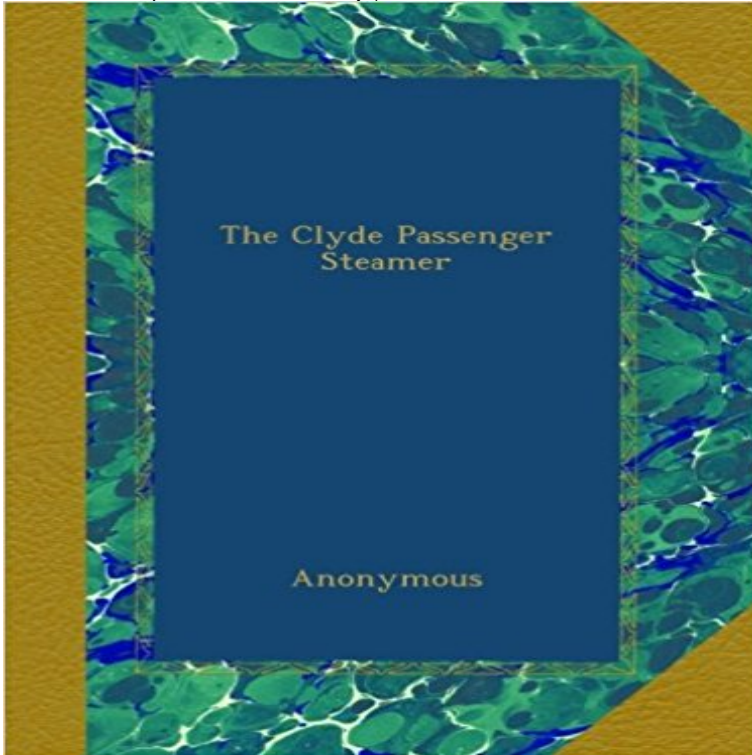


The Clyde Passenger Steamer
