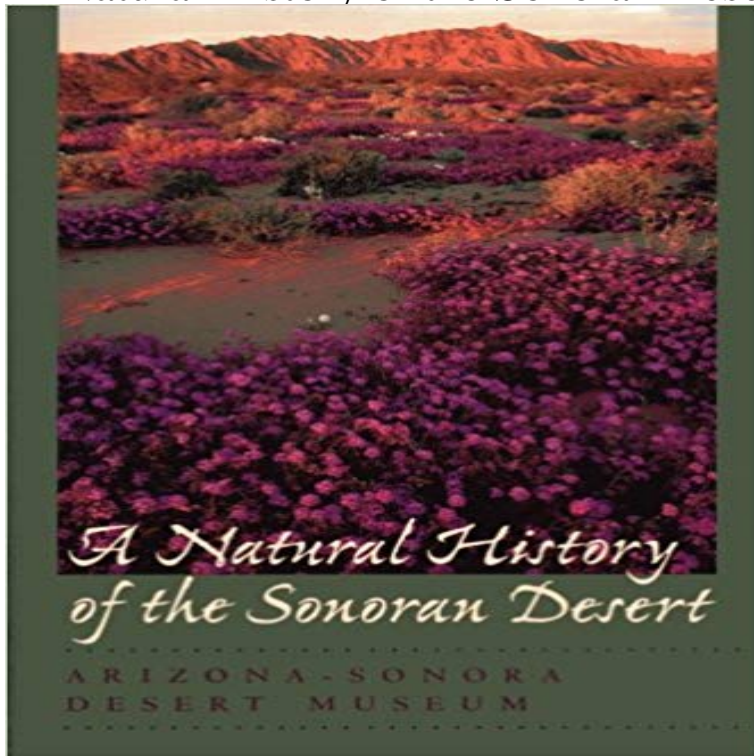


## A Natural History of the Sonoran Desert

It is a homeland that rambles over some 120,000 square miles (320,000 km<sup>2</sup>) in two countries and five states.
