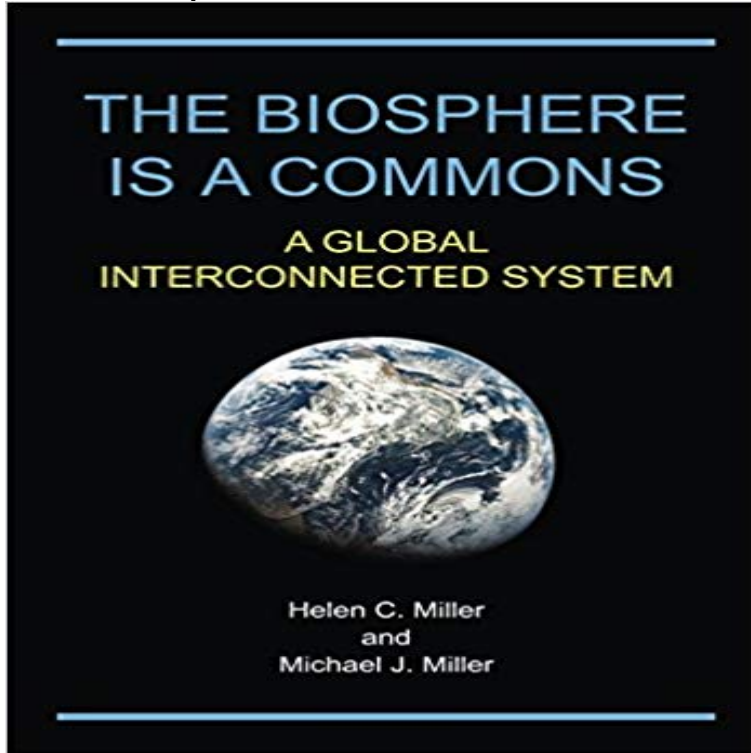


The Biosphere is a Commons: A Global Interconnected System

The last chapters overview Public Lands and Special Places and The Role of Environmental Organizations, and the book ends with a short epilogue about A Sustainable Global Commons and an appendix about Legislation Enacted to Prevent Ruin of a Commons. Information about these aspects of the earth and human history can be found spread among environmental science textbooks or other sources, but the authors provide a broad, yet detailed overview of these subjects that is integrated into a uniquely compact and readable book. It tells the amazing story about how in a few centuries humans have changed a large proportion of the biosphere. It also explains what we have done to slow down the destruction of parts of the global web of life contained within the biosphere in an effort to begin to find a sustainable path into the future.
