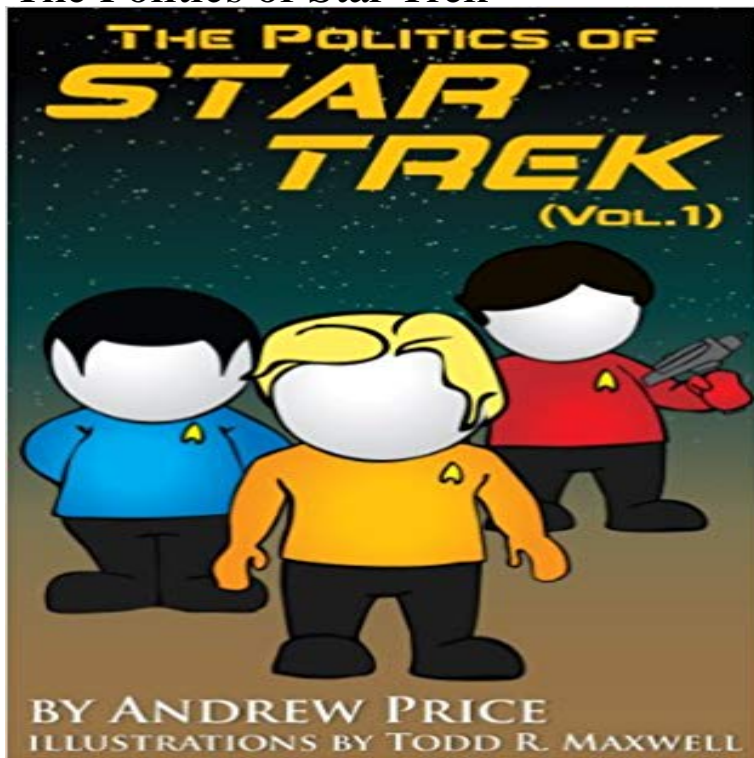


The Politics of Star Trek
