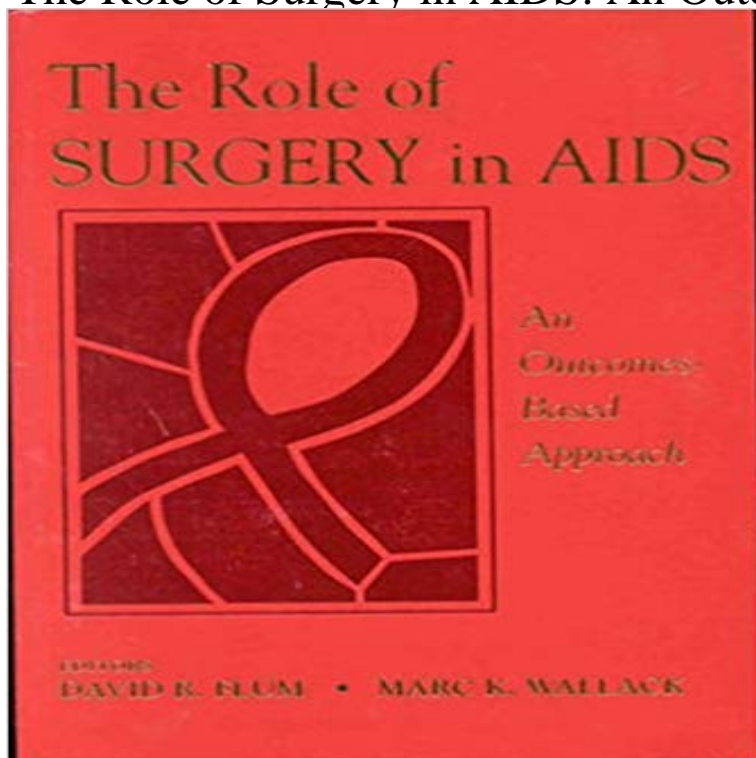


## The Role of Surgery in AIDS: An Outcomes-Based Approach
