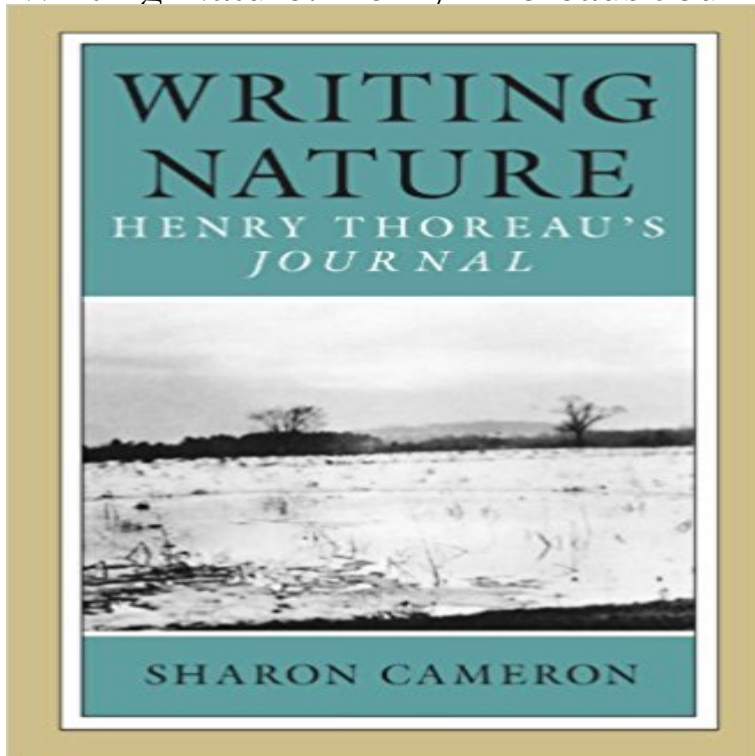


Writing Nature: Henry Thoreaus Journal
